



Financing education and training

There are several ways to pay for education and training

- Support from parents/guardians
- Employer support (e.g. assumption of or contribution to costs which may be linked to additional obligations, reduction of working hours without loss of pay)
- Cantonal subsidies and loans
- Other sources of funding (e.g. foundations, educational institutions)
- Part-time jobs
- Personal savings

In Basel-Stadt, the office responsible for questions in financing education and training is: **Amt für Ausbildungsbeiträge** (cantonal grant office). Scholarships and loans can be applied for by submitting a request: www.bs.ch/stipendien
Before you start looking for other funding options, the government claims should be clarified.

Scholarships and loans in the canton of Basel-Stadt

Scholarships are one-off or recurring cantonal education grants. Loans are also grants, but they must be repaid within a certain period of time.
